



Athabasca University Science Lab Committee Mandate

The Athabasca University Science Lab Committee (AUSLC) oversees issues pertaining to laboratory safety, procedures, and facility planning.

1. The committee will provide leadership in dealing with laboratory regulations regarding the use of hazardous chemicals and biological agents.
2. The committee will assist laboratory staff with the operating procedures of the laboratory and laboratory courses where deemed appropriate.
3. The committee will be involved in the planning of laboratory facilities.

The AUSLC is an ad-hoc advisory committee that reports routinely to the Chair for the Centre for Science.

The AUSLC also makes recommendations as necessary to the Director of Arts and Science (Dean of the Faculty of Science and Technology), Vice President and Assistant Vice President Academic, Vice President (Finance) regarding policy matters related to science lab activities, lab safety, and security.

This mandate adopted at the AUSLC meeting August 14, 2009 and was approved by the Centre for Science Committee on August xx, 2009.
